



1891 - 1946 [up to 26 December 1946] Manipur defeated in the 1891 Anglo-Manipur War Manipur State forfeited to the Crown

 $\frac{2 \text{ September } 1946}{\text{Prime Minister.}}$  formed **Interim Government** headed by Jawaharlal Nehru as Government of Interim Government is the successor Government of the Government of India by the Crown.

27 December 1946 Manipur excluded from INDIA by Order in Council
1 January 1947 Manipur State Constitution Act 1947 enacted by His Highness

1 July 1947 Bilateral Agreement made between two Governments

5 July 1947 Created States' Department

15 July 1947 F.F. Pearson Chief Minister of the Interim Council

14 August 1947 M.K.Priyabrata Chief Minister of the Manipur State Council [INDEPENDENCE DAY]

## Restored the lost sovereignty of Manipur\_

1947 - 1949 [up to 14 October 1949]

11 June 1948 Assembly Election in Manipur 18 October 1948 First Assembly Session in Manipur

27 November 1948 Constitutional Government formed in Manipur [Ruled about 11 months]

15 October 1949 Manipur (Administration) Order 1949 [3.11 month ahead of Republic Day of India] Overthrown the Constitutional Government by illegal Order of Indian Government

22 January 1950 States' Merger (Chief Commissioners' Provinces) Order 1950 by illegal Order Manipur annexed to India and occupied by Indian.
